Role Description:

SGO Photo-Journalists will be outgoing, creative and passionate individuals, keen to promote and encourage students to incorporate a more sustainable way of living within their university and at home.

They may team up with a journalist or film-maker to capture a story, or work under their own steam. They will be encouraged to find stories relating to sustainability, both positive and negative, and to document them in fun, eye-catching ways. These stories will be shared across the Student Green Office website, blog and social media sites, and The Grapevine, to raise awareness among the student and staff populace about news and events happening in and outside of the university.

Experience photographing events, wildlife or people, maintaining a blog or having any previous writing/photography experience would be desirable, but is not essential.

They will work with the Sustainability Department for up to 4 hours a week on a flexible basis to fit around the student's studies.

Photographing, editing and producing engaging visual media to promote the SGO and its activities, for publication on the website, blog and social media sites

Documenting events in fun, eye-catching ways through photography

Getting creative with photo-blogging to promote news and upcoming events

Representing the SGO to students and staff they meet while photographing

Raising awareness about causes they care about, with support from the SGO
