

Community Engagement Advocate - Job Description

Job Description:

The Community Engagement Advocate will be an outgoing, creative individual who is passionate about promoting and encouraging more sustainable living practises within the university and at home.

They will help to promote local community projects and events by creating innovative ways to gain the engagement of the wider student body across all campuses. They will be working collaboratively with the University's Sustainability Coordinator, and will be encouraged to take part in one or more local community groups.

An awareness of or membership of one or more local projects relating to sustainability would be desirable, but is not essential.

They will work with the Sustainability Department for up to 4 hours a week on a flexible basis to fit around the student's studies.

Opportunities:

Helping to promote local community projects and groups, such as Transition Towns, the Makers' Market, the UNA or the Canterbury District Fairtrade Steering Group

Representing CCCU on local working groups, such as Canterbury 4 Environment

Getting involved with and promoting events in the local community

Joining and participating in a university sustainability working group

Raising awareness about causes they care about, with support from the SGO

Contract:

This is a voluntary role; and may take up to 4 hours per week, depending on availability.
